BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows:

- 1 **1.** The Compulsory, Free Universal Basic Education Act, CAP Amendment of
2 C52, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004(hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act
3 "Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill.
- 4 **2.** Section 9, paragraph (e) of the Principal Act is amended to Amendment of
5 include a new paragraph (iv) and shall be read as follows: Section 9
6 (iv) Ensure that the curriculum for pupil for each term includes
7 Entrepreneurial, Vocational and Technical Education/Training and Skills
8 for primary, junior and secondary school.
- 9 **3.** The Bill may be cited as the Compulsory, Free Universal Basic Citation
10 Education (Amendment) Bill, 2025.
